

Cups and napkins are in the cabinets in each classroom.

An allergy alert sheet is also on each bulletin board. Check this before serving snack.



Children from age three through second grade are eligible to be a part of Worship Enrichment.

Leftover drink can be placed in the refrigerator in Room 205. Leftover snack may be placed in the marked tin in the same cabinet as the cups and napkins.

You are expected to stay with the children until they are all picked up.

Leave new registration cards in the box outside Room 204. If you are unable to obtain a registration card please leave the new child's name on the sign in sheet so we can follow up and obtain that information.

If there is any accident/incident that occurs during Worship Enrichment that requires first aid or serious intervention, please make sure the parents as well as the supervising staff person are aware of it. A first aid kit is in each room on the top shelf of the cabinets.

Important Things for You to Know

Children usually leave the sanctuary for Worship Enrichment after the Offertory, before the Sermon. Please wait until the singing of the Doxology is completed.

This program has two groups: one is designed for children three-year-old preschool age through pre-kindergarten and the other for those in kindergarten through second grade.



Children participate in activities that build relationships with other children.

Leaders for the week meet the children outside the sanctuary and escort the groups to their rooms.

- Elementary (K-grade 2) meets in Room 205.
- Preschool (3-5 yrs) meets in Room 203.

Children make the transition to the next level on Promotion Sunday, the beginning of the Fall Sunday School Program. During the summer they stay with the group they were with during the previous school year.

Children may transition into the preschool group as they turn three if they exhibit the maturity to function in the group. If not, they may stay in the nursery until they enter the three-year-old class in the fall. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

All children should have a Worship Enrichment registration card on file. The family of new participants should receive a registration card and a copy of this information sheet. They are next to the bulletin boards in each room with the attendance chart.

Children may only be released to parents or other adults who are listed on their registration card. Children may not pick up other children.

During Worship Enrichment children will have a simple snack and participate in activities designed to help them get to know the other children and begin to feel comfortable in the church setting.

Families are asked to make picking up their children their first priority after worship as the parents serving as volunteer leaders that day cannot leave until all children are claimed. Remember, our volunteers often have children of their own to retrieve.

The families of children participating in Worship Enrichment will be asked to serve as volunteers on a rotating basis. Depending on the number of children in the group this will occur about six times per year.

When you serve as a volunteer

About three times a year we make a new schedule of volunteers. This is mailed to each family. Every family participating in Worship Enrichment is asked to serve.

If you will be serving as a single parent, please advise us so we can schedule another person to serve with you.

Families are expected to find their own substitutes if they are unable to serve on the week assigned.

Each family brings snacks for the group of children they are leading.

They should make the office aware of the change so it can be noted in the weekly bulletin. In case of an unanticipated emergency, please contact us by calling the church office so arrangements can be made to cover the group.

Each family brings snacks for the group they are leading. Plan on a total of between 10 and 15 children. The snack usually consists of a beverage (preferably juice) and something to munch on (pretzels, fruit, simple cookies, crackers). **Please do not bring popcorn or juice with red or purple dye.**



Parents are asked to volunteer on a rotating basis if their children participate in Worship Enrichment.
