

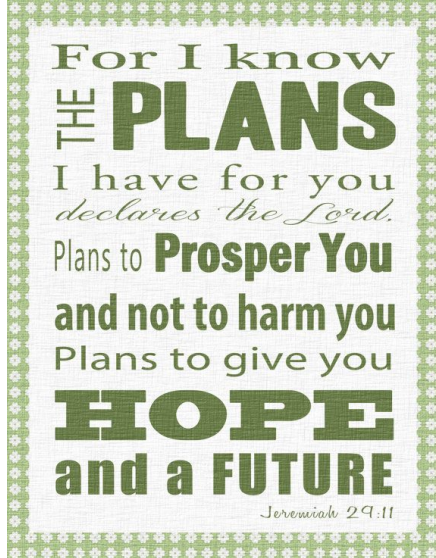
Hello parents,

1. specially for the parents of our infants: Please begin to think about transitioning your child out of a morning nap. When they move up to the toddler class in August, they will no longer have a scheduled nap time. Once in the toddler room, we will not use bottles either, so, in the upcoming months, you may want to begin using a spill proof/sippy type cup for your child.
