

The committee, comprised of health officials and a retired physician, felt that Trinity could begin to relax some of our guidelines. We will now be able to provide light refreshments in Moor Hall and the garden area, as well as begin passing the offering plates in worship. Masks and "every other pew" spacing will continue to be observed in worship until a vaccine is available for our children. We will no longer provide reserved seating areas in the sanctuary, and everyone is encouraged to continue the 6 ft. physical distancing guideline.
